**Course Information:** This service is provided free of charge by the Adult Education and Literacy Department of Region 5 Education Service Center. The program of study will serve as an “on-ramp” course for students who are wishing to obtain their CDL Class B license through Lamar State College Port Arthur.

- job search through WorkInTexas
- use Microsoft Excel & Word for day to day on the job duties

**Attendance Policy:** Students are required to complete a minimum of 15 contact hours in the “on-ramp” course before being accepted into the LSCPA CDL Class B program. Once in the

LSCPA CDL CClass B programs, students are required to follow the attendance policy of Lamar State College Port Arthur as well complete at least a minimum of 15 hours of training with Lamar State College Port Arthur.

**Evaluation:** Pre and post tests will be given to learners according to TWC AEL guidelines.

**Materials Needed:** Software Code (\$125)

Learners will need to bring a tablet for notetaking and completing activities. For distance learning, participants will need to provide their own cell phone or laptop computer.
